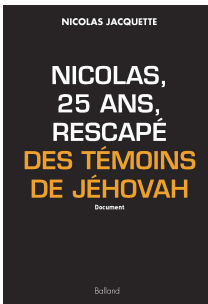
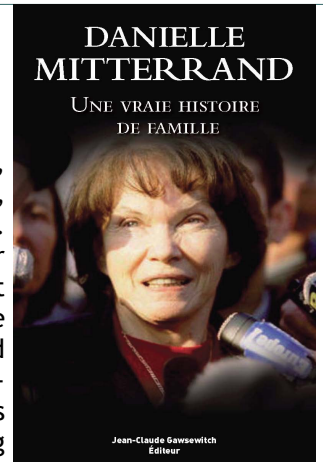
A true family story

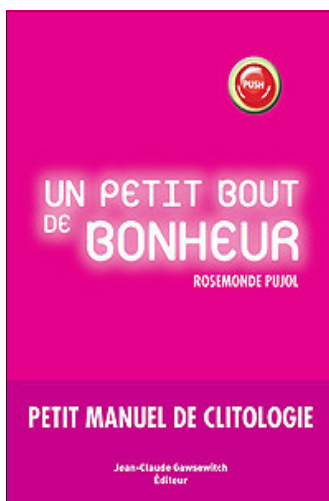
Nicolas, 25, fugitive from the Jehova's Witnesses

French citizen of African descent, the author is an active denouncer of the sexual exploitation of children. For more than ten years, she has been conducting investigations in

the most dangerous crime environments. Certain African families living in Europe run child prostitution networks, with the tacit agreement of the parents, who get a percentage of the gains. Perfectly normal looking and integrated, the victims go to school and do their homework, but unlike their colleagues, they continue their work day in closed-circle prostitution networks, pleasing generous and otherwise "honourable" clients. This drama has been going on for years, and the author provides a series of testimonies from pimps, clients and child prostitutes.

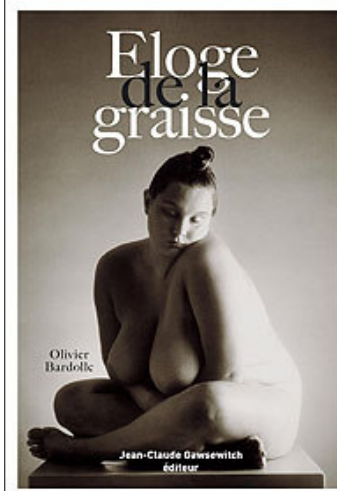
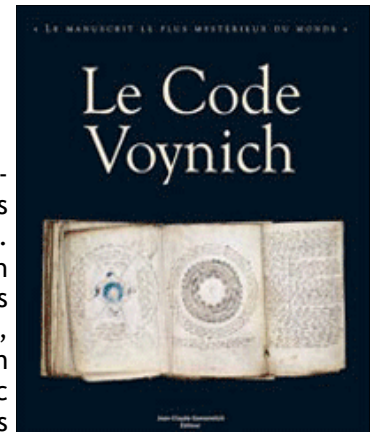
Le Code Voynich

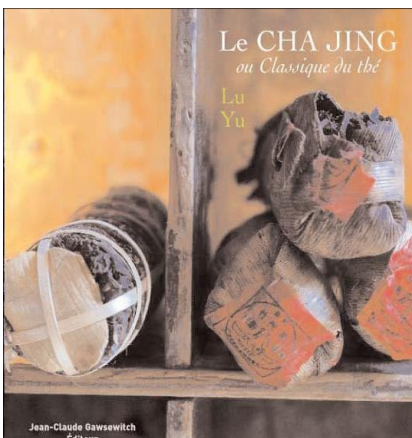
A tribute to the fat

Tea has its Bible, too. The Cha Jing, or Tea Classical, was born 1.200 years ago, during the Tang dynasty. All about tea, in 10 chapters: cultivation, crop, preparation, tasting, tools, the plant itself, in the purity and the sobriety that characterize the Classical Chinese language. The Cha Jing is also an art of frugality and rigour, rooted in the most important currents of the Chinese, taoïst, buddhist and confucianist thought. Lu Yu was not only an expert, but also a subtle scholar and a great moralist, who showed a true philosophy of tea, guided by the need of excellence and by a constant search for refinement. An illustrated book, with the replication of the text in ancient Chinese, coloured pictures and engravings.
